



Poster Competition 2021 Task Sheet

I Supereroi

All student entries must adhere to the following guidelines, as well as those stipulated for each year level:

- No larger than A3
- Include a painting, drawing or collage
- Be **clearly** labelled with the student's name, year level and school – a sticker on the back of the poster is preferred.

Foundation, Grade 1 and Grade 2:

Students write the heading "Il mio supereroe preferito è..." on a prominent part of their poster and complete the sentence by inserting the name of their favourite superhero. Students must write FIVE **adjectives, nouns** or **noun groups** describing or stating features of the character.

Example* [Il mio supereroe preferito è Superman] **forte; coraggioso; mantello rosso; veloce; capelli neri**

Grade 3 and Grade 4 students:

Students write the heading "Il mio supereroe preferito è..." on a prominent part of their poster and complete the sentence by inserting the name of their favourite superhero. Students must include FIVE **extended noun groups or simple sentences** on their poster describing or stating features of the character.

Example**

[Il mio supereroe preferito è Superman.] **È molto forte.; È sempre coraggioso.; grande mantello rosso; Volava velocemente.; Ha i capelli neri.**

Grade 5 and Grade 6 students:

Students use the prompt "Il mio supereroe è..." on a prominent part of their poster and complete the sentence by inserting the name of a superhero *from literature or real life*. Students must include FIVE sentences outlining why the person/character is a superhero.

Example**

[La mia supereroina è mia comare Anna.] **È molto dolce.; È sempre simpatica.; Giochiamo a Scrabble insieme.; Leggiamo i libri a casa insieme.; Mi insegna italiano.**

* These are examples only and are not indicative of the breadth of possible student responses.

** These examples are of a mid to high-range response and are not indicative of the variety necessary in a high range response. Please see the Level Descriptors for further details.



Poster Competition Guidelines 2021

1. Individual student entries will be accepted from students in Foundation to Grade 6
 - a. Entries completed by more than one student will not be assessed and the students will receive a Participation Certificate.
2. Entries will be accepted in the following categories:
 - a. **Open Competition:** This section is for ALL entries in the competition. All students participating in the competition will receive a certificate (Partecipazione, Merito, Lode, Pregio, Eccellenza) and the posters judged the best in each year level will be awarded first, second, and third prizes. All prizewinners will receive a trophy.
 - i. Prize winners usually receive a book prize, however, COVID restrictions in Italy, plus difficulties with postage may mean this is not possible in 2021.
 - b. **Teacher's Choice:** Each school is invited to nominate **one** student who has demonstrated a strong work ethic and positive attitude towards the completion of their poster and to Languages lessons more generally. This student's poster may or may not be entered in the Open Competition. All students entered in the Teacher's Choice section will receive a certificate, and trophy to be awarded at the Presentation Ceremony.
 - i. an organisation providing Community Language classes counts as ONE school and as such, one entry will be accepted per organisation.
- 3. Entries close Friday 24 September 2021**
4. An entry fee of \$5 per entry must be paid via EFT or cheque when posters are submitted.
 - a. Cancellation of student participation does not entitle participants to a refund.
 - b. The entry fee is not transferable between students.
 - c. When payment is made via EFT details of the transaction must be included on the Remittance/Entry form.
 - d. When payment is made via cheque, the cheque should be made payable to "Dante Alighieri Society" and crossed not negotiable. The cheque should be enclosed with the posters and sent to the Society's office.
 - e. If you wish to pay in cash, this can only be done **in person** at the Dante office. All appointments must be arranged in advance with the Competition Coordinator. **We are a voluntary organisation and do not keep office hours.**
 - f. All payments must be accompanied by a completed remittance form (part of the Entry Form). The Remittance and Entry form must be **emailed** to the Competition Coordinator
5. All entrants must be listed by the teacher on the forms provided in the following manner:
 - a. In order of Year level (Foundation first, Grade 6 last)
 - b. Students in each Year level must be listed in alphabetical order by surname
 - c. First Name, Surname format (i.e. Jack Nguyen NOT ~~Nguyen, Jack~~)
 - d. Do not use **CAPSLOCK**
 - e. Please check spelling of names and surnames before submitting list.
 - f. If you need to change an entry list after submitting it, you must re-send the amended list in its entirety.
 - g. **ALL entry forms must be TYPED and EMAILED** to the Competitions Coordinator at postercomp.dante.melbourne@gmail.com
 - i. Entries **will not** be accepted without an electronic copy of the entry form.
6. Posters should be packaged carefully (preferably flat) and addressed to the Society's office.
 - a. Posters may be hand delivered to the Society's office as arranged with the Competition Coordinator.
 - i. The office will be open on **Saturday 24 September from 2pm to 4pm for poster drop off.**
 - ii. All other delivery times must be negotiated via email with the Competition coordinator.
 - iii. Posters are **NOT** to be left at the Co.As.It Resource Centre.
7. The judges' decision is final and no communication will be entered into regarding results.
8. Results will be disseminated to teachers in early Term 4.
9. After results are distributed, teachers will have one week to double check the spelling (etc.) of student names. A precise date will be communicated via email when results are sent.
10. The Presentation Ceremony will happen during Term 4, COVID dependent.
11. Posters and certificates will be available for collection from the Society's office and at the presentation ceremony, COVID dependent.
 - a. Teachers will be informed of possible collection times from the Society's office once certificates are available.
 - b. Other collection times will not be possible as **we are a voluntary organisation and do not keep business hours.**

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- c. Collection arrangements are subject to change at the discretion of the Coordinator and in accordance with Victorian COVID-Safe guidelines.
